Blended Learning

This Lifeguard Training Blended Learning class allows students to complete coursework at home and attend less class time in-person. This comprehensive training program is for the individual who wishes to become a lifeguard. This will certify the passing student in CPR for the Professional Rescuer, First Aid, and Lifeguard Training. Students must be at least 15 years old (proof of age must be shown at the first meeting), and pass a water skills test to be admitted into the class. Bring class material, swimsuit, towel, and comfortable clothing.

Youth Swim Lesson Descriptions

Guppies (L1) - (Minimum age 3 years) - Students focus on developing independence, confidence, and basic safety skills. Students are supported and assisted by the instructor in all skills. Skills include - bobbing, floating, retrieving objects, water entry and exit, pool safety, and moving through the water.

Seahorses (L2) - Swimmers learn to coordinate leg and arm actions and swim independently on both front and back, building on level 1 skills to increase confidence, and water safety. Skills include - unassisted floats, glides, big arms, elementary backstroke, and rollovers. *Prerequisite skills* - completely submerge underwater unassisted, and be able to perform assisted skills with face in water.

Marlins (L3) - Swimmers learn breathing technique for freestyle. They will increase their confidence and skill base in freestyle, elementary backstroke, and backstroke. They will become more comfortable in deep water while developing treading skills. Skills include - side breathing, treading, coordinated freestyle and backstroke, introduction to breaststroke kick, and diving progression. *Prerequisite skills* - Front and back floats, big arms with rollovers, elementary backstroke 5 yards, backstroke 5 yards.

Sting Rays (L4) - Swimmers will enhance their freestyle and backstroke while building onto their breaststroke kick. They will be introduced to butterfly kicks, turns, and continue diving progression. Skills include - side butterfly, open turns, and racing dives. *Prerequisite skills* - side breathing 10 yards, backstroke 15 yards, and treading water for 30 seconds.

Sharks (L5) - Swimmers refine their swimming technique for freestyle backstroke, and breaststroke. They learn to coordinate their butterfly. Skills include - all strokes, racing dives, and turns. *Prerequisite skills* - Freestyle and backstroke 25 yards, breaststroke 10 yards, treading water for 1 minute, and dolphin kicks.

Spring Swim Lessons

Private and Group Lessons are 30 minutes each.

A maximum of 5 children will be enrolled in each group lesson.

Levels 1 & 2 and 4 & 5 have been combined due to low instructor availability.

Highlands Dolphins Aquatic Club



The Highlands Dolphins Aquatic Club (HDAC) is a positive, energetic swim program designed to help participants achieve their personal best. Regular practices contribute to life long fitness skills. Annually, all swimmers must register with USA Swimming and will have the opportunity to compete regularly in local USA swim meets year round. Swimmers are encouraged to continue with swim lessons to receive hands-on instruction. All amounts displayed are the monthly fees per group.

Red Group

Participants must have the ability to swim 25 yards (one length of the pool) freestyle, backstroke, and breaststroke and have some knowledge of butterfly.

Participants must have the ability to swim 100 yards (four lengths of the pool) of freestyle, 50 yards backstroke and breaststroke, and 25 yards of butterfly.

Gold/Silver/Bronze Group

This group is for swimmers 11 years and older who are able to swim 400 yards freestyle, 200 yards backstroke and breaststroke, and 100 yards of butterfly. Participants must also be able to complete 2000-3200 yards at practice. This group works on improving form, endurance, speed, and fitness. Swimmers are encouraged to participate in summer dual meets and may participate in USA meets year round.

Early Education Center

The Early Education Center offers year-round, full day childcare from 7:30am-6:00pm for children ages 3 months through 5.5 years. Each classroom is staffed with 3 early childhood educators.



Philosophy

The Early Education Center (EEC) is a Reggio-Emilia inspired, play based program that is focused on creating a positive, safe, and nurturing environment for children and their family. We believe children learn best when they are given the freedom to explore, create, discover, and have hands on experiences with the world around them. Through careful observation of the children's interests, teachers create a rich curriculum and environment that supports each child at their own developmental level. Our learning environment allows for all children to experience the high-quality care they deserve and the freedom to be the natural and playful learners they are meant to be!

Tours and Admission

We are currently offering virtual tours only. Tours are conducted on weekdays from 9:30am-11:00am and 3:00pm-4:30pm. To schedule a virtual tour please contact the directors. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. To be added to our waitlist please download an application from the website and submit it with a \$50 non-refundable fee. During our enrollment period, priority is given to siblings of currently enrolled families, residents of the Highlands District, and siblings of students enrolled in the Afterschool Program for school aged children. Occasionally we do have openings during the school year, in which we will pull from the waitlist.

The ASP program provides a safe environment for children to enhance their physical and social development. Our licensed program and trained staff strive to provide the life skills necessary for children to be confident and happy citizens of our community. 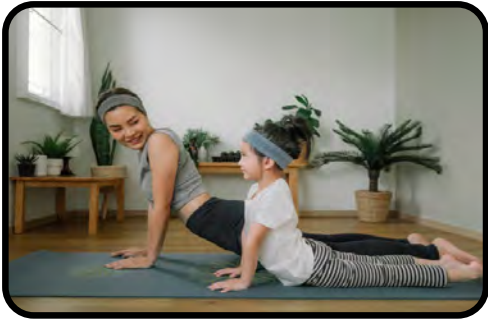
Each Themed Week Includes: Morning and Afternoon Snack, Swimming, Thursday Fun Days, Sports, Crafts, and Local Hikes.

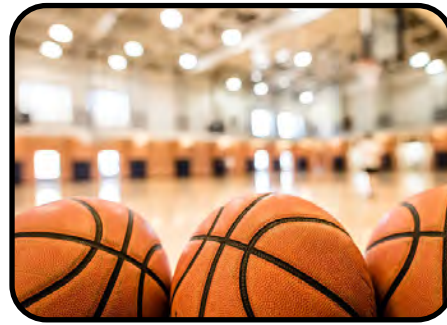

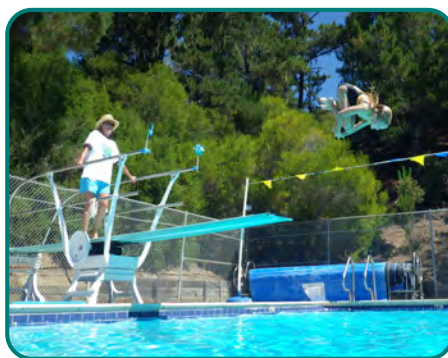

Resident Tennis Court & Pickleball Reservations



The Highlands Recreation District maintains three tennis courts. On most days, the courts are used for private and group lessons for all ages. On evenings and weekends, local USTA teams and Highlands Residents play serious matches or friendly sets. The courts are open and available from 7am-9pm daily. When not used for lessons or matches, court access is restricted to Highlands Residents and their guests only.

Pickleball is now available on Court 1!

To access the tennis courts, Residents must purchase a key from the registration office, Monday - Friday, 9am-12pm and 1pm-5pm.

Court reservations can be made up to two weeks in advance, when available. Residents must register for an account through Sign-Up Genius to make a reservation.

The weekly access code is sent through email. To be added to the Resident tennis schedule email list, please verify your residency by emailing admin@highlandsrec.ca.gov

As a courtesy to other tennis players, daily tennis court reservations should be limited to a 2-hour maximum.

Fitness Center

Highlands Recreation District maintains a Fitness Center exclusively to Highlands Residents. The Fitness Center houses a Precor Treadmill, Elliptical, and FTS Glide Functional Trainer. As well as an Exercise Bike, a Rowing Machine, Weight Benches, and Dumbbells.

Registration

- *Register in person, by phone, or online at registration.highlandsrec.ca.gov
- *Walk-in and phone registration is available M-F from 9am-12pm & 1pm-5pm.
- *Enrollment is ensured only when class fee is paid in full.
- *If waitlisted, registrants will be notified via email if space becomes available. A response must be received by 10am the following business day or the space will be offered to next on the list.

Payment

- *We accept payment in Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Discover, Check, or eCheck.
- *All registrations paid for by credit or debit card are subject to a 3.95% service fee. This fee is paid directly to the company processing the transaction and is not charged by the District.
- *All Service Fees added for credit and debit card payments are final. Service Fees will not be refunded or credited should a class be cancelled or if a participant requests to unenroll.
- *Paying by Check or eCheck will not incur a service fee.
- *You may prepay for no more than 3 months of service.
- *A \$20 service charge will be incurred on a returned check and for stop payment/re-issuance of a refund check.
- *A \$50 late fee is charged per participant per class if monthly fee is not paid by the end of the **5th business day of the month.**

Enrollment/Changes/Cancellations

- *Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis.
- *In the event that enrollment does not meet minimum requirements, the HRD may cancel the class. Notification will be distributed to registrants and class fees will be refunded or credited.
- *Prices are subject to change without notice.
- *Please see Emergency Camp Packet for Seasonal Camp Refund Policy.
- *If waitlisted, registrants will be notified via email if space becomes available. We must receive a response by 10am the following business day or the space will be offered to others.
- *If a single class is cancelled by the Highlands Recreation District for any reason, a prorated district credit will be automatically applied to your household credit. No cash, check or credit card refund will be given.
- *Credits can be applied to any program at the Rec.
- *Credits must be used within one year of issue.
- *If enrolled in the After School Program or Early Education Center, payment must be received by the end of the 5th business day of the month. Otherwise, a \$50 late fee will be charged.
- *If enrolled in our ACH/ARB payment program, cancellation or changes must be received by the 15th of the month prior to the ACH/ARB withdrawal.

Refund Policies

- *Participants in enrichment and swim classes may cancel enrollment up to 3 business days prior to the first class to receive a full refund of the session.
